Cloisonne Enamelling



Enamelling (vitreous) is the art of fusing glass onto metal. The ancient and beautiful technique of Cloisonné Enamelling uses fine silver wires to create design and patterning, and around which coloured glass frit is laid and fired. Working on fine silver and using an exquisite range of Japanese colours, we will be creating small pieces of enamel suitable for use as jewellery.

Basic bench skills are required for this workshop.

During this course you will cover the following areas

- What is Enamel?
- What are the different techniques of enamelling.
- Learn about equipment used to make Cloisonné enamels.
- Design a piece of Cloisonné enamel.
- Make a piece of Cloisonné enamel.
- Explore design development.
- Find out where to buy Enamelling supplies and materials.

The class is flexible to work with the students requirements.
The amount of work produced will be variable depending on individual progress.
