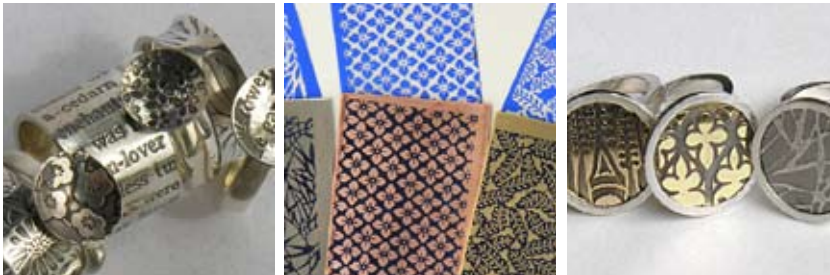

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## Etching



**Etching can create a rich surface decoration that can be textures, patterns, writing or imagery.**

Learn to etch a variety of metals using a product called PnP paper, a material onto which we will photocopy black and white images. The resulting 'black' images are then attached to the surface of our copper, brass or nickel silver and etched using a mild solution called Ferric Chloride. Using Ferric Nitrate we will do the same etching process on Silver. The etched metal can then be made into items of jewellery.

Basic bench skills are required for this workshop.

During this course you will cover the following areas

- Look at what makes suitable images when using the PnP process.
- Try out on our range of metals.
- Discuss and try out the etching process.
- Use the etched metals to make items of jewellery.
- Learn to work safely with etching solutions.
- Discuss other Etching processes.
- Explore design development.
- Find out where to buy Etching supplies and materials.
