Texturing Metal



Textured metals can add a new dimension to making silver jewellery. In this workshop, you will learn a variety of techniques to bring new elements of design to your work. These techniques will include Roller Printing using many materials, reticulation, fusing, hammering with special hammers and stamping. You will also learn how to make some simple texturing tools. The samples you make can be used to make jewellery.

Basic bench skills are required for this workshop.

During this course you will cover the following areas

- Learn how to safely make simple texturing tools out of cheap hammers and centre punches.
- Try out these tools on a variety of metal.
- Try out Reticulation of Sterling Silver.
- Try out fusing scraps of Sterling Silver.
- Learn to use the rolling mill with a variety of materials.
- Learn how to use it safely and how to correctly use various materials without damaging the rolling mill.
- Try out on our range of metals.
- Discuss how these 'samples' can be utilized in jewellery making.
- Make some Jewellery.

Some copper and brass will be supplied for the first class. Please bring \$20.00 to cover the metal. Additional metals will need to be purchased by the students, according to the work they want to make, from the jewellery suppliers. Bench skills are required. Not for beginners.
